Plants and animals have the hardest job of surviving in the wild world. There are many ways plants and animals have adapted to survive. Camouflage is one way animals adapt to survive. For some animals, this means that their fur, scales or skin are a similar colour to the land around them. Deer, for example have brown fur that blends in with trees. So, it's harder for predators to see them. This saves them from becoming prey to larger animals. Some animals can change colour to match the environment. Many people think of chameleons when they think of this type of camouflage, but rabbits are a great example as well. Some rabbit's fur will change colour depending on the season. Their fur maybe brown in summer to match the trees but the brown fur will fall out and white fur will grow in winter to blend in with the snow. Some moths and butterflies have designs on their wings which makes them look like snakes or owls to scare away the predators. (Para 1)

Many plants, however, grow flowers with colourful petals to attract bees. The bees help pollinate the flowers so that they can help produce new flowers. Instead of hiding, some plants and animals develop structures that aim to hurt anything that tries to hurt them. Some plants develop thorns so that animals will not eat them. Porcupines have spikes called quills covering their backs, so that animals won't dare to mess with them, let alone eat them! (Para 2)
