**Summary of the discussion with the PTA Members held on 10 August 2024 (Saturday)
at 11:00 a.m. at DPS Navi Mumbai**

The Principal welcomed the gathering and thanked the parents for taking their time out to attend the Annual General Body Meeting of PTA 2024-2025. It was informed that as the required quorum was not met, the official Annual General Body Meeting would be rescheduled on 24 August 2024.

On the basis of request from the parents, an informal meeting/discussion was held. The following points were discussed: -

- The Principal apprised about the exemplary results of class X and XII along with successful placement of the students in reputed colleges. All the PTA Members applauded the efforts of the students, teachers and the Principal for producing excellent results.
- Concerns regarding heavy school bags, bus transportation, cleanliness, career guidance sessions, safety and security concerns, requirement of more counsellors, sports and self-defence activities/awareness classes, Scouts and Guides/Cubs & Bulbul programmes, provision for shade at the school entrance, suggestions for guest speaker programmes etc were discussed. The Principal apprised that action has already been taken and there is lot of improvement in most of these areas. The observations and suggestions from parents were noted.
- The Principal apprised the parents about the following renovations in infrastructure and other facilities: -

*Completion of the construction of the new block by the end of August 2024 thus ensuring an appropriate class strength for each section.

* An additional pathway exiting from gate no 5 to be opened shortly to help ease traffic woes.

*Special needs of senior secondary students for particular examinations are periodically met by appropriate arrangements on behest of the parents.

* Renovation of the school auditorium and administrative block.

* Additional racks in the classrooms to keep books. A Bagless day to be introduced once a month for all the students up to class VIII.

* Exhaustive fumigation and pest control practices undertaken daily in school.

Members voiced appreciation regarding the swiftness with which all repair, renovation work and additional facilities was carried out.

Parents lauded the efforts of the Principal in bringing about a sea change in the school in all areas. They also appreciated the efforts of the Principal and the teachers in ensuring the holistic development of the students. The Principal thanked the parents for reposing faith in him and the system. The meeting ended on a positive note with a vote of thanks to the chair.
