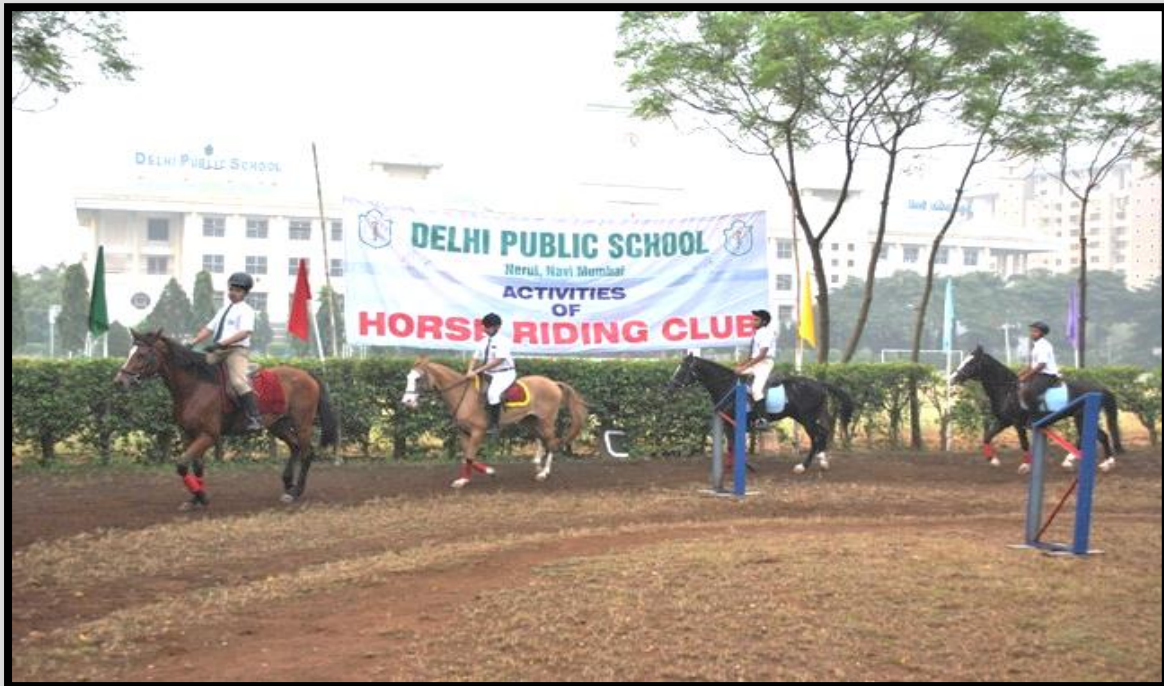

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CBSE: DPS, Navi Mumbai, secures 88.41% as class avg

MUMBAI: CBSE's declaration of the AISSCE & AISSE – 2022-2023 results on May 12, 2023, has once again resounded the bugle for DPS Navi Mumbai's success, placing it high up on the crest amongst the schools across the city with a whopping score of 88.41% as a class average. Jayram Aityyar's mind-boggling 99.4% in the science stream has encouraged his juniors to shoot for the moon. He has been closely chased by Suketu Patni and Ashish Ranjan with 98.8% and 98.2% respectively. Jaanavi Anand's 98.2% not only made her one of the school toppers but also sealed her position as the Topper in Humanities. Reeya Chintamani Koli with 97.8% and Tamanna Bharat with 97% closely follow Jaanavi's footsteps as the toppers in Humanities. The Commerce stream basks in the light of fame with

Ananya Saxena and Gurushi Jain scoring 97.2% while Krish Bhadresh Shah follows with 97%. Tanishka Singh, Saumya Sinha and Saumya Kessar finish a close third in the stream with 96.8%. Out of the 296 students who took the AISSCE Examination this year, 275 students (93.22%) have passed with distinction, with 151 (51.3%) scoring 90% and above in aggregate and 66 (22.37%) scoring 95% and above in aggregate.

If the Examination Warriors of Class XII placed their Alma Mater in the clover of success, the Class X students answered their clarion call by further adding a feather to the cap of the school's success. Out of the 233 students who took the AISSE examination, 119 students (51%) scored 95% and above in aggregate and 169 (72.5%) scored 95% and above in

aggregate. The stupendous performance of the stalwarts has made DPS Navi Mumbai ace the test with 92.22% as the Class Average with a 100% result, all passing in First Division. The DPSNM pennant flies high with Ananya Mehta and Kavyam Agrawal scoring 99.6%. Their ginormous success ranks them as the city topper for Mumbai and Navi Mumbai. The bugle of success rings through the city once again as Maanya Patel follows his friends with his stupendous 99.4% and Pranjal Banerjee, Atin Gupta, Shanjini Ashish Jain and Siddhartha Deo competently follow with 99.2%. Shaimali Mahe and Shreshth Agarwal add more sparkle to the success with their mind-boggling 99% while Jaeynaa Godawat, Hashir A Khan, and Sarthak Agarwal add more colours to the joy with their 98.8%.

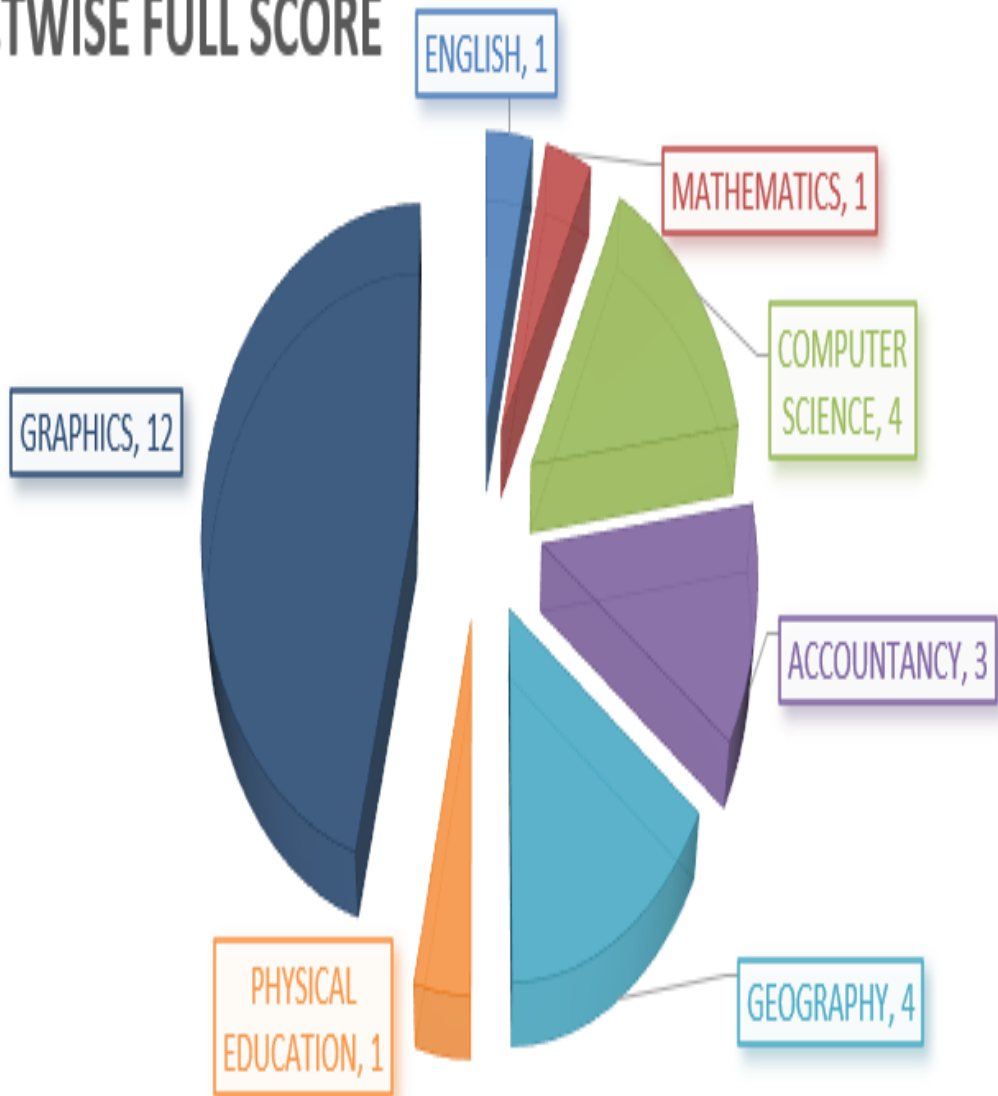

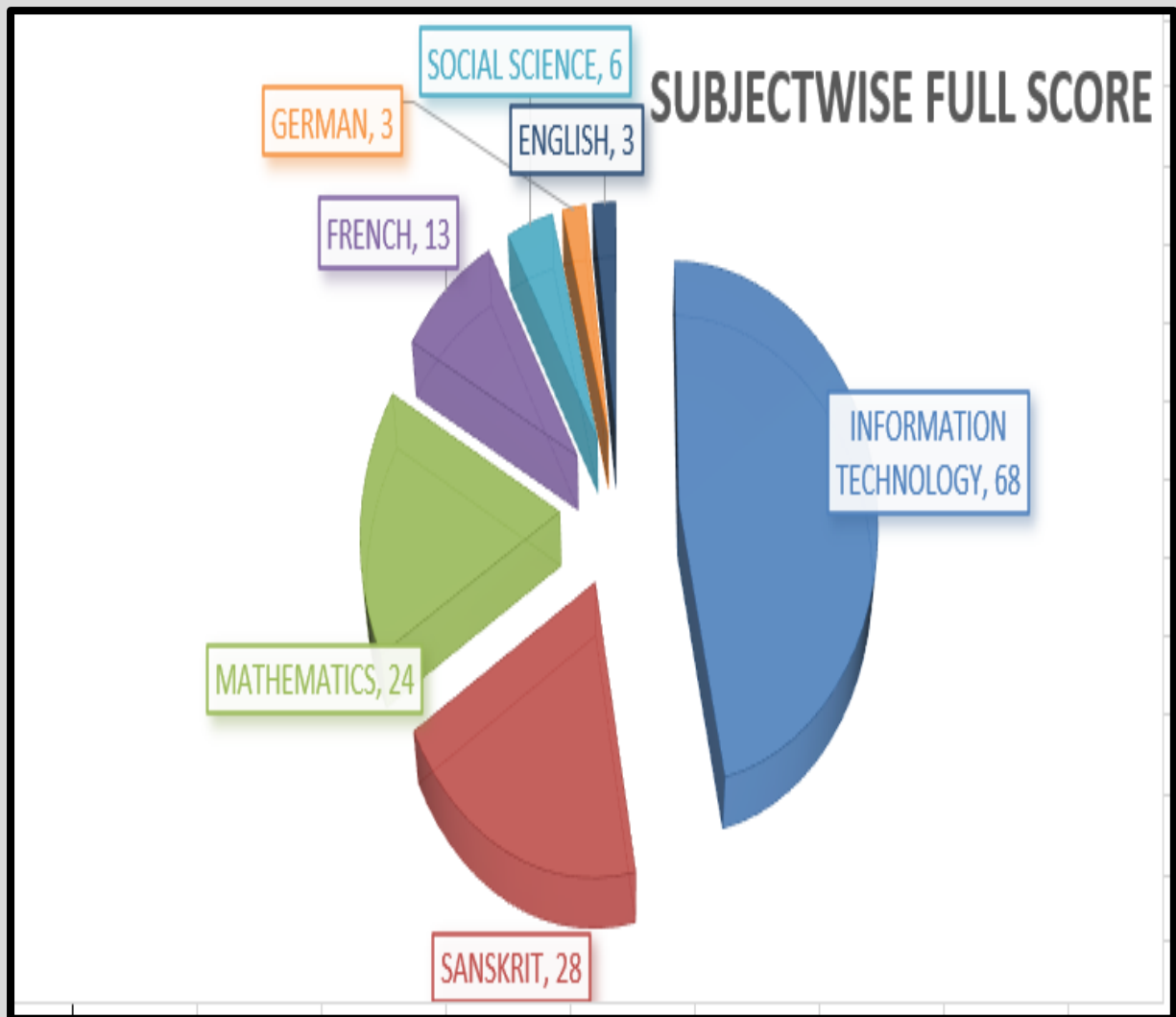

CELEBRATION OF FLAMINGO FESTIVAL:

The Flamingo Festival in Navi Mumbai on May 14, 2022 highlighted the need for the conservation of migratory birds and their habitats; a bird watching event that was held at DPS Lake along with an exhibition on flamingos at DPS auditorium. The festival started at 12.30pm and went on till 6pm. Navi Mumbai environmentalists came together to organise the first ever Flamingo Festival in the city. The festival, organised by Save Navi Mumbai Environment, Nat Connect and Kharghar Wetlands and Hills forums, was held on the occasion of World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) on May 14, backed by NMMC, Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) and the State Mangrove Foundation.

WMBD is a twice-a-year awareness-raising campaign held on the second week-end of May and October, highlighting the need for the conservation of migratory birds and their habitats. “The Navi Mumbai Flamingo Festival, listed as part of the WMBD global events, has added significance as the civic body has given the Flamingo City tag to the city that attracts the country’s largest number of pink birds,” said BN Kumar, director of NatConnect Foundation.

Apart from the Thane Creek Flamingo Sanctuary (TCFS), the migratory birds also land at wetlands such as DPS Lake and the twin wetlands of NRI and TS Chanakya. The festival was free to enter for all.

“Film shows, educational material on flamingos and mangroves, flamingo dance, craft event and photo exhibition were organised for the festival. Right from senior citizens to children, all age groups enjoyed the festival,” Jyoti Nadkarni of Kharghar Wetlands and Hills Forum, said.

Sunil Agrawal of Save Navi Mumbai Environment forum said, “The flamingo festival will also focus on the dwindling CRZ and constant threats to wetlands. The ongoing construction adjoining the twin wetlands of NRI and TS Chanakya is a glaring example of such violations.”
